Christmas is a coming!

The school is a hive of activity as the festive season is upon us. Preparations are now fully underway for the Christmas production with rehearsals taking place and support for costume requirements sent out to parents. Your support with this is much appreciated as we lost all the costumes the school had accumulated over the years due to damage in the storage area where they were stored during the school expansion works.



We have now sent out parent mail communication

inviting you to purchase tickets on line to come and watch the production next week. On the day your will sign off on a list to enter the concert. If your name is not on the list you will be turned away as under health and safety we can only accommodate 100 guests per presentation. We have increased the number of performances to four with a day set aside for parents with young children and then adults only. Each year we ask parents to respect the fact that under health and safety we are only able to accommodate 100 seats per performance and that as the production involves every child in the school the length of the production will be at least 90 minutes. However each year we gave guests walk out after watching their own child thus disrespecting the contributions of the whole performance and involvement of all the children.

Please note if you have purchase a ticket it is to watch the WHOLE production!

This year we have managed to arrange for all the children in Year 1 and 2 to have the fantastic opportunity to see a pantomime in a real theatre. The children were taken to the Watford Palace Theatre on Monday 5th December to watch Beauty and the Beast. A great time was had by all.

Thanks for supporting our Sewa Day appeal this year with the Second hand toy sale in aid of the children of Great Ormond Street. In addition to the money raised from the sale of toys which amounted to £361.33 we also received a generous donation of £294.50 from members of our school community. The total amount raised and donated on behalf of Kenmore Park Infant & Nursery was £655.83

For Children In Need and Outright 2016 in total we raised £609.01 (this too included a generous donation of £250 from a member of our school community).

We held a cake sale and non-uniform day which raised £301. 04 in total which will be used to purchase treats for the children for Santa, costumes for our school production and raffle prices for our Christmas children's raffle.

Years 1 & 2 (KS1): 8.50 a.m. – 3.20 p.m.


