visits to check the health of their child's teeth.





School Travel Plan

As an accredited GOLD travel plan school we continue to promote WOW – Walk on Wednesday encouraging every child/family to walk or park away from the school and walk to school at least every Wednesday.

Each month we will celebrate by announcing the class with the most pupils walking to school on Wednesdays.

During the month of January congratulations go to Ladybird & Clownfish Class.

Later in the year we will host events to support walking, scooter or cycling and we will invite parents/careers to join us for those events too.





Please remember not to obstruct residents drive ways or park on the zigzag lines when dropping and collecting your children from school.

Health & Safety

Please remember that Infant school children should not be left unaccompanied in the playground in the mornings. The doors open at 8.50 a.m. and therefore they should remain in the supervision of the adult who is dropping them off at school until they are safely handed over to the class teacher.

Similarly at the end of the day, the children are handed over to the adult collecting them and it is their responsibility to then supervise the child. There continues to be the issue of children playing on the school equipment which should not be used unsupervised at the end of the school day. We do not take responsibility for any injuries that take place to children on school equipment which is being used without authorisation at the start and end of the school day.

Last week a child was brought to the school office as the adult who had collected the child did not supervise them once the child had been collected.

Also once the school gates are open we are not aware of all the school families and it is a prime time for a stranger to walk on to the school site, so please take greater care and always keep your children by your side once until they are handed over to a member of the school staff at the start of the school day and with you once collected at the end of the school day. The school gates are locked promptly at 9 a.m. in the morning and at 3.45 p.m. at the end of the school day. So please do not allow your children to wonder off and start playing on the infant and junior school equipment.

After School Club.

The After School Club which provides parents with child care from 3.30-5.45 p.m. Monday to Friday has now moved to the school canteen and is managed by the schools. The children have settled well and there are children who attend every day or a few days per week. Now that the school is managing this provision we are able to offer parents casual child care provided your child is registered as a casual user. This means that you can phone on the day and ask for your child to attend the after school club and pay when you collect. There are a number of options too. You can select from the full session at £7 (3.30-5.45 p.m.) or a short stay at £4 (3.30-4.15 p.m.).

We will also be sending children to the After school club if you are late collecting your child at the end of the school day and you will be charge at the short stay or full day rate depending upon the time you collect your child.

It is in your best interest to collect your child on time at the end of the school day or arrange to be a casual user.
