Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to announce that our Nursery children will be taking part in the Whole School Christmas production. Nursery Uniform

Please be reminded that our Nursery children **must** come to school wearing appropriate clothing. Our Nursery Uniform consists of a **grey jumper, grey jogging bottoms, white t shirt and black shoes**. When getting ready for PE lessons, it is important that your child is able to take off their shoes and socks independently. Children should wear shoes that **have a Velcro fastening, not shoelaces**. Please ensure that your child's footwear and clothing is clearly labelled. Encourage your child to take their shoes and socks on and off at home by themselves.

Daily routines

When dropping off or collecting your child from school, **please take any scooters, bikes or toys back home with you**. We have a very limited amount of space outside of the Nursery Entrance and toys and equipment from home simply cause a health and safety issue, which can make it difficult for our children to enter or leave safely. Thank you for your ongoing support with this.

A Right to be safe (A19)

Please remember to **stand well away from the Nursery door** when teachers are dismissing your children. Our teachers need to **keep our children safe** and crowding by the door makes this difficult to do. Now that it is getting darker earlier in the day, it is especially important

that **children are given enough space to walk** through and find their parents at the end of the day. Thank you for your support.
