## Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very pleased with how well our children have settled back into the routine after the half term break. They have now started their ICT lessons and were very excited to venture outside of the nursery classroom and walk to the computer room. The children created firework pictures on the computers and chose the different colours that they wanted to use with the mouse. As many of our children are used to playing with tablets at home, some children found clicking the buttons on the mouse a little tricky. If you have access to a computer at home, you can support your child with developing their computer skills by using the mouse and keyboard together.

## Nursery communication.

**PASSWORDS:** It is important that parents remember the passwords that they have chosen to authorise the collection of their children. There may be times when our staff ask for this password before we will allow children to be dismissed. **If the person collecting your child does not know the password, they will not be allowed to take your child**
