### Easter Holidays.

### School Uniform

Please be reminded that our Nursery children **must** come to school wearing appropriate clothing. Our Nursery Uniform consists of **a grey jumper, grey jogging bottoms, white t-shirt and black shoes.** When getting ready for PE lessons, it is important that your child is able to take off their shoes and socks independently. Children should wear shoes that **have a Velcro fastening, not shoelaces.** Please ensure that your child's footwear and clothing is clearly labelled. Encourage your child to take their shoes and socks on and off at home by themselves.

### Health & Safety.

Thank you to all those parents who have supported us with making our school a safe place **by taking any scooters, bikes or toys back home with them.** It is important to keep the space outside of the Nursery entrance as clear as possible so that children can enter leave safely. Please ensure that this message is passed on to any childminders or other adults that may be dropping off or collecting your child from Nursery.

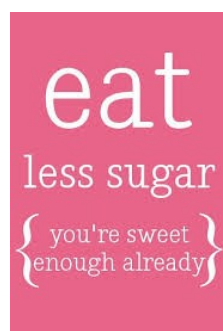


## Measures to improve oral hygiene.
