Dear Parents/Carers,
We hope that you all had a restful half term break! The children in the Nursery have settled back in very quickly and seem to have grown so much over the break!

School Uniform

Please be reminded that our Nursery children **must** come to school wearing appropriate clothing. Our Nursery Uniform consists of a **grey jumper, grey jogging bottoms, white t shirt and black shoes**. When getting ready for PE lessons, it is important that your child is able to take off their shoes and socks independently. Children should wear shoes that **have a Velcro fastening, not shoelaces**. Please ensure that your child's footwear and clothing is clearly labelled. Encourage your

child to take their shoes and socks on and off at home by themselves.

We would like to remind parents to ensure that their **child always has a spare set of clothes to change into**.

These clothes can stay in the Nursery on your child's peg and will only be used if your child has an accident or gets wet whilst playing. We have noticed that some of our children no longer have their own set of spare clothes to change into, so we have had to use our own collection of Nursery clothes in case of an accident. **If you think that you may have an item of clothing from the Nursery collection, please hand them in to a member of staff as soon as possible**. The clothes that belong to the

Nursery are clearly marked with a letter 'N' on them. If these items are not handed back to us, we will not have spare clothes for your child to change into if they have an accident. We will then need to phone parents during the Nursery session and ask them to bring in clothes for their child to change into, which may be inconvenient for our children, parents and staff. Thank you in advance for your support with this.

Thank you to all those parents who have supported us with making our school a safe place **by taking any scooters, bikes or toys back home with them**. It is important to keep the space outside of the Nursery entrance as clear as possible so that children can enter

and leave safely. Please also inform childminders and other adults collecting or dropping of this too.
