No Jewellery Policy

We have noticed a number of children coming in to Nursery wearing jewellery. Please remember that bangles and dangly earrings are not part of our school uniform and that your child will be asked to remove these items. Some children have also started to bring in toys from home. There are plenty of toys for the children to play with at Nursery. Please keep toys from home at home. It can be upsetting for a child if their toy gets lost or is broken. Thank you for your support with this.

As our children are heading towards their final term in Nursery, we are beginning to prepare them for their time in Reception. We will hold another Stay and Play session on Wednesday 12th July where you can find out ways to support them with their move into full time school. It is important that you check the noticeboard outside of the Nursery entrance regularly so that you always know what events are happening at school. More details about this Stay and Play session will follow closer to the time.

After the half term break, we will be inviting parents to join us for our 'soft start' at the beginning of your child's nursery session. Parents can walk into the nursery with their child on **Tuesdays and Thursdays**, and can spend the first 10 minutes of the session engaging in activities with their child. This will give you the opportunity to see the different challenges that are set up for the children each week and also help your child to develop a love for learning.
