Spare Clothes

We would like to remind parents to ensure that their **child always has a spare set of clothes to change into**. These clothes can stay in the Nursery on your child's peg and will only be used if your child has an accident or gets wet whilst playing.

We have noticed that some of our children no longer have their own set of spare clothes to change into, so we have had to use our own collection of Nursery clothes in case of an accident.



If you think that you may have an item of clothing from the Nursery collection, please hand them in to a member of staff as soon as possible.

The clothes that belong to the Nursery are clearly marked with a letter 'N' on them. If these items are not handed back to us, we will not have spare clothes for your child to change into if they have an accident. We will then need to phone parents during the Nursery session and ask them to bring in clothes for their child to change into, which may be inconvenient for our children, parents and staff. 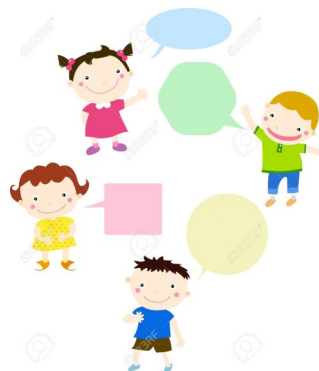
Communication and Language Stay and Play Session
