Learning Focus:

Over the next few weeks, the children's learning will be focussed on the theme of 'Dinosaurs'.

Some of the activities the children will be doing are:-

Literacy:

Exploring non fiction (information) books, writing simple words and sentences; practising letter formation; writing and describing dinosaurs.

Letters and sounds:

We have now moved on to teaching phase 4 of letters and sounds which focuses on blending sounds together for reading and segmenting for spelling.

Every Friday we will send home some words we have taught at school for you to practise with your child.

Maths:

Learning about subtraction—taking away objects from a given amount; Subtraction symbol/operation; counting back from a number; recording calculations as number sentences.

Show & Tell (every Wednesday)

Please refer to the homework sheet which can be found in your child's book bag on a Friday.

Others:

Learning facts about dinosaurs, painting, drawing and making dinosaurs using a range of different materials.
