We have noticed how much our children have grown up and matured over the last few weeks and we are excited about getting them prepared and ready for their time in Reception.

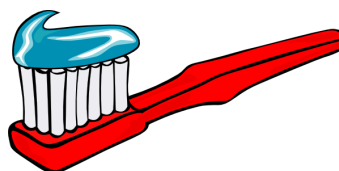
It is important to keep the space outside of the Nursery entrance as clear as possible so that children can enter and leave safely.
