

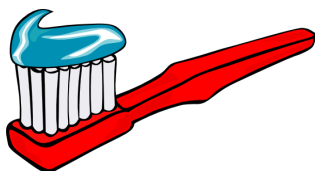


Nursery Newsletter

Dear Parents/Carers,

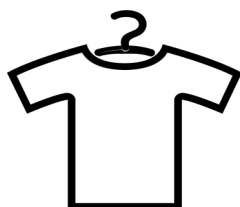
We would like to thank all of the parents who came along to our tooth brushing sessions last week.
