Attendance

This term we are hosting a number of meetings with parents with the schools LA attendance officer where children's attendance has continued to fall despite writing to parents informing them of low school attendance. We rigorously monitor school attendance and time keeping, Ofsted, at our recent inspection were also very concerned about the schools attendance rates, but felt the hard line the school is taking is a positive step in challenging poor attendance and time keeping, so that it does not impact on pupil progress and achievement.



I am pleased to say that we have also sent out a number of letters to parents where their child's attendance had improved since our previous correspondence. So our thanks to those families who have worked in partnership with us.

I would like to remind parents that the school year ends on Tuesday 24th July at 2.15 p.m. and all children are expected to complete the school term on that day and NO EARLIER. Any absences during that week will not be authorised and parents could face severe penalties!

Nursery p.m. session: 12.45 – 3.45 p.m.

Harrow Schools Counselling Partnership - REMINDER



This is a reminder that the school has received three years of funding from the John Lyons Trust which has allowed us to employ the services of Harrow Schools Counselling Partnership to help us look after your child's emotional health and wellbeing.

The aim of the service is to provide therapeutic support and advice to children, parents and staff across the school.

The Space.

Part of the provision is to offer a lunchtime drop-in service, called The Space, to all of the children in the school. They can come along and talk about anything that might be troubling them either on their own or with a friend. Today's children have many concerns about friendship, peer pressure, social media, body image, SATs and transition to junior school. The Space offers them a place to talk about their concerns and to get support. Please let the school know if, for any reason, you do not want your child to attend The Space.

Parent's Drop-In

In addition, there will also be a confidential drop-in service for Parents. If you have any concerns about your child, need some strategies to help them at home or you need a space for yourself. The drop-in will be available on **Wednesday mornings between 9.00-10.00 am**. Remember our Counselling Services Manager **Maryam Rashid** is here to help you.
