Books

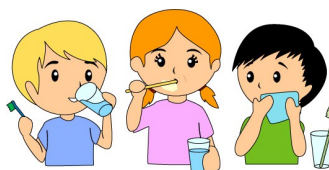
Reading books are sent home every Friday and we would appreciate if parents could spend at least 5 minutes every evening reading with their child.
